

The Green Star Rating Tool states "Where 90% or more (by mass)...of an item can be categorised as 'Environmentally Innovative', the project may enter the entire item as 'Environmentally Innovative' in the calculator and may disregard any non-compliant components". Any fabric can be used as fabrics are almost always under 10% by weight of a furniture item.
